Nursery Improvements

Sonos Sound System

Carousel Nursery now has a new Sonos sound system in place we currently have it in the babyroom but we will soon have it throughout the nursery in each of the rooms. It is a wireless sound system controlled by wifi through the computer in the office using speakers in each of the rooms, we will have a range of music including children's nursery rhymes and relaxing music for sleep times.

Preschool Toilet's

We have recently had a third toilet put into the ground floor toilet for the preschool children along with a fresh lick of paint.

Children's Fingers to Get Even Greener at Our New Nursery Allotment

Carousel Nursery now rents an allotment in Stamshaw which we have sourced for the children to visit and use, we aim to take the children to the allotment daily (providing the weather is good) and encourage the children to help plant flowers and grow vegetables which we will use back at nursery and send home too, this will help to develop their fine and gross motor skills, teach them about how we plant, being responsible and taking care of living things as well as giving them the skills and knowledge to

know where their food comes from and know that they can make a contribution to their daily lives and be a valued member of society.

Digital Learning Journey's

We have invested in an additional two iPad's for the staff to use the Evidence for Learning App in the toddler and preschool groups and we have upgraded our subscription for the app on the iPad that now allows parents/carers to see your child's (no one else's) learning journey observations from home and you will also be able to add your own observations from home so you can share what your children have been learning and achieving at home.

Staff Training

All staff at Carousel have completed e-learning this year on staff recruitment, the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum, child neglect, equality and inclusion, special educational needs and disabilities, effective safeguarding practice, promoting positive behaviour and reflective practice in early years.

The staff have also attended the following training courses; good practice in school readiness, basic awareness in safeguarding, an in depth exploration of characteristics of learning and teaching, behaviour strategies, understanding new Ofsted, staff performance and through the eyes of a 2 year old.

Important things to remember

Chicken Pox

We have had several cases of chicken pox recently so if your child has not yet had them then please keep an eye out for the symptoms. A reminder children can have chicken pox *more* than once, so if they have had it before they may potentially get it again. The exclusion period for chicken pox can differ in length but they can return to nursery after 5 days off and once ALL the spots have scabbed over.

Spare Clothes

All children need to have a bag packed with enough named, clean clothes (whether potty training or not) to last through the day (more if they are potty training) this can be kept on your child's peg but not in a plastic carrier bag. We still have some parents who have not provided this yet and your children naturally will become messy during their day eating, playing and exploring with us.

As we all know the weather is unpredictable, so please be prepared for all occasions, otherwise your child may miss out. Please think practically when dressing your child, its best to dress children in layers and we can take them off if it's warm enough. Please can all parents bring in a hat and sun cream to keep at nursery so that your child can take part in outside activities when it's sunny and hot.

Also if your child has been sent home in nursery clothes could you please return them. Thank you.

Kids Club and School Holidays

All parents/carers if your children attend the nursery all year round and you do not book holiday for your child by the given date for half term, they will be booked in and you will be charged normally. We do

require all holiday to be requested with 4 week's notice; otherwise you will be charged for your child's absence.

Children who attend term time only or for their funding are able to attend during the holidays at the normal chargeable rate, please ensure you book well in advance to avoid disappointment.

Don't forget we offer a Kids Club for children who are not registered with Carousel, offering childcare for children up to the age of 12 years old.

Safety

Please can all parents/carers ensure the front door is shut firmly when leaving the nursery, before leaving the porch area, also ensure you are not letting anybody else in whether you know them or not parents can use finger prints or ring the door bell and qualified staff will let them in.

If you have not yet been registered for your finger print please see Mary, Michelle or Becky in the office.
